Sport: Hector van d'Abdijhoeve is competing very successfully with Irish rider Tomas O'Brien. He represented the BWP Studbook this year at the FEI World Breeding Championship for Young Jumping Horses after winning the Cavan 5-Year-Old Qualifier earlier in the season. Several weeks ago he won the Cavan Classic 5-Year-Old Showjumping Championship.

Breeding: Hector van d'Abdijhoeve was sired by Cabrio van de Heffinck (Cassini I x Ca-lato), winner of the 2012 CN International Grand Prix at Spruce Meadows, and is out of the mare Diana van d'Abdijhoeve (Utrillo van de Heffinck x Fuego du Prelet). This damline, Hannover stamm 550, has produced the international showjumpers Optimum van de Wellington, Busch van het Prinsenveld, Eros van den Bosrand, Valesca van het Breehof, Camona van den Bosrand, and Kiss Me Glück. Among the scores Hector van d'Abdijhoeve received in his WSI inspection were 8 for canter and 9 for athleticism, jumping technique, jumping scope, and jumping reflexes.

HECTOR VAN D'ABDIJHOEVE IS CAVAN CLASSIC 5-YEAR-OLD CHAMPION

On 11 November at Cavan the WSI-approved stallion Hector van d'Abdijhoeve (see above profile) and Tomas O'Brien won the 5-Year-Old Cavan Classic Showjumping Championship. This is Ireland's major indoor showjumping championship and previous winners, including the WSI-approved stallion Ulysses m2s, often go on to successful international careers after winning this championship.

WSI 2012 CHAMPION FOALS

Dakota m2s (Desir du Chateau - Cherokee Bella m2s x Apache d'Adriers x Ekstein x Landino) and Deo Volente m2s (Condios - Violetta Bells m2s x Ekstein x Landino x Voltaire) tied for the honor of being named WSI Champion Colt Foal. Docent m2s (Condios - Desir du Coeur x Desir du Chateau x Corrado I x Renomee) is the Champion Filly Foal. The two Champion Colt Foals descend from the mare Pandina Bella.

YOUNG WSI-APPROVED STALLIONS AND MARES DOMINATE IRISH SHOWJUMPING

WSI-approved stallions and mares won the following Irish showjumping championships in 2012:
Cavan 5-Year-Old Championship

Dublin 5-Year-Old Championship
Millstreet Discovery 4-Year-Old Championship
National 4-Year-Old Championship
National 5-Year-Old Championship

In addition:

Two WSI-approved mares qualified for the Dublin 4-Year-Old Championship; Five WSI-approved stallions and mares qualified for the Dublin 5-Year-Old Championship; and one WSI-approved mare qualified for the Dublin 6-Year-Old Championship. In the summer of 2012 the WSI approved 13 mares and stallions and, by virtue of the approvals, they became eligible to compete in the qualifiers for the Dublin Horse Show 4-, 5-, and 6-year-old classes. Ten of the thirteen WSI approved horses competed in the qualifiers (77%). Three of the five 4-year-olds competed and two qualified for the championship in August (67%). All six of the 5-year-olds competed and five qualified for the championship (83%). One of the two 6-year-olds competed and one qualified for the championship (100%). Overall 80% of the WSI-approved stallions and mares that tried to qualify were successful. Two WSI-approved stallions competed in the 2012 World Breeding Championship for Young Jumping Horses at Lanaken.
