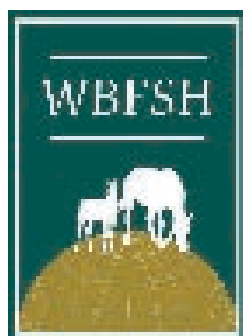

WSI NOW A FULL MEMBER OF WBFSH

On 11 November the General Assembly of the World Breeding Federation for Sport Horses (WBFSH) voted to ratify the Executive Committee's recommendation to grant Full Member status to the Warmblood Studbook of Ireland. WSI is now a Full Member of the WBFSH, and Irish Warmbloods are able to compete at the World Breeding Championships for Young Showjumping Horses and Young Eventing Horses. And Irish Warmblood stallions and mares now are eligible to be approved by and/or entered into many studbooks around the world for breeding purposes.

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR WORLD BREEDING CHAMPIONSHIPS COMMITTEE

Now that WSI is a Full Member of the WBFSH, Section 62. (2) of our Rules and Procedures calls for nominations and election of three Members in Good Standing to serve on a committee to govern the selection of horses to compete in these young horse championships.

We invite every Member in Good Standing to nominate himself or herself and/or other Members in Good Standing to serve on this committee.

We intend to conduct the business of the committee via telephone and email, so geographical distance will not be an issue for committee members.

Nominations close on 15 January 2015. Elections via email will be conducted on 30 January.

MEETING WITH THE IRISH SPORTS COUNCIL

Dr. Thomas Reed, the Breeding Director of WSI, recently met with

three officials from the Irish Sports Council (ISC), the statutory body that provides funding to Irish sporting bodies, to discuss a number of issues including the 5.5 years of discriminatory actions against WSI by Horse Sport Ireland (HSI), which receives annual funding of approximately €1.3 – 1.5 million from the ISC. The meeting was convened at the request of the Chairman of the Public Accounts Committee of the Oireachtas (Ireland's legislature). The meeting was useful, and WSI now expects the ISC to use its influence over HSI to motivate this umbrella body and FEI affiliate to cease its discriminatory practices, which result from HSI's management of the Irish Sport Horse Studbook and its fear of competition from WSI.
