WSI – KWPN PARTNERSHIP OFF TO A FAST START

The reception to celebrate the new partnership between WSI and KWPN took place in County Kildare on 12 September, and among the speakers was the Dutch Ambassador Paul Schellekens. The Ambassador explained that equestrianism is the second most popular sport in the Netherlands, and he extolled the many benefits the partnership will produce for Irish and Dutch breeders. The reception was well attended and generated a lot of positive reactions among breeders, riders, owners,

producers, and the equestrian press. Since the launch WSI and KWPN inspectors have been conducting informal assessments and formal inspections of mares, foals, young horses, and stallions at five venues throughout the country. The final stages of the stallion inspection are scheduled for Millstreet on October 31 – November 2, and everyone is invited.
