Importation of a Horse into Ireland

When an Owner/Keeper imports a horse into Ireland from another EU country an Owner/Keeper must lodge the original registration document with an Irish Passport Issuing Organisation within 30 days of the horse entering Ireland. Complete and post this form along with the passport and fee to the Warmblood Studbook of Ireland. The Studbook is required under Irish law to submit the information provided on this form to the Central Equine Database.
